



LEGISLATION REVIEW AND REPORT ACT

6PB2

An Act of the House of Commons of Atovia to provide for executive feedback regarding Acts passed by the House of Commons of Atovia; and for connected purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by His Royal Majesty the King, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Commons of Atovia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Article 1: Requirement to Review

- (1) All parliamentary legislation, as defined by Article 163 of the Basic Law, shall be subject to a review, except in the case that the legislation is no longer in effect by the time the review would have begun;
- (2) Emergency legislation, as defined by Article 164 of the Basic Law, shall not be subject to review as a part of this Act.

Article 2: Responsible Minister

- (1) The review shall be conducted by the Minister to which the text of the legislation most pertains.
- (2) If parts of a piece of legislation pertain to different Ministers, the Prime Minister shall facilitate the review and assign each part to the Minister to which it pertains.
- (3) If it is unclear to which Minister the legislation most pertains, the Prime Minister shall assume the responsibility of conducting the review.
- (4) The Minister who is responsible for conducting the review will hereafter in this act be referred to as the “responsible Minister”.

Article 3: Review Process

- (1) The review of each piece of legislation shall be comprehensive and examine both the statutory provisions as well as the operation and execution of the legislation.
- (2) This review shall be conducted within one year but no earlier than six months from the date of the legislation coming into force.

Article 4: Report

- (1) The responsible Minister, as determined by Article 2 of this Act, shall compile a report on the findings of their report and shall set it before the House of Commons after the review is completed.
- (2) The report shall also include a statement regarding any changes to the legislation that the responsible Minister recommends.

Article 5: Inclusion of Clause in Future Legislation

- (1) The following text shall be included in all future legislative bills:
 - (1) “Within one year and no earlier than six months of this act coming into force, the responsible Minister shall initiate:
 - (a) a comprehensive review of the provisions and operation of this Act; and
 - (b) a report on the review to be set before the House of Commons, including a statement on any changes recommended by the authors of the review.”

Article 6: Commencement

- (1) This Act shall come into force immediately upon the granting of royal assent by the Monarch of the Kingdom of Atovia.

Article 7: Ratification

- (1) This Act we hereby pass as an Act of the House of Commons on the fifth day of Vienat in the seventh year of the Atovian era, the twenty-sixth day of August in the year two thousand and twenty-three of the common era.
- (2) This act shall be inserted into the official collection of the public acts of the Kingdom of Atovia.
